about going out that evening locally. Rob suggested we go to Finnegan's,
and before I knew it we were all on the way over (Dillon fell asleep).
Got to Finnegan's at about 12:30 - "it was popping, a legitimate
bar scene." We were checked in at the door by the bouncer and proceeded
to the bar. I bought a round of beer. Didn't finish the beer
because a fight broke out in the bar. A big kid beat up the bouncer
and quickly resolved. Everyone was kicked out of the bar. We waited
until the last possible minute to see if they would keep the bar open

Tons of cop cars arrived to the scene to help control the situation. Students were still yelling and screaming. It took about forever, about 35 min, for the ambulance to come. I had a pretty good grasp of the situation. I

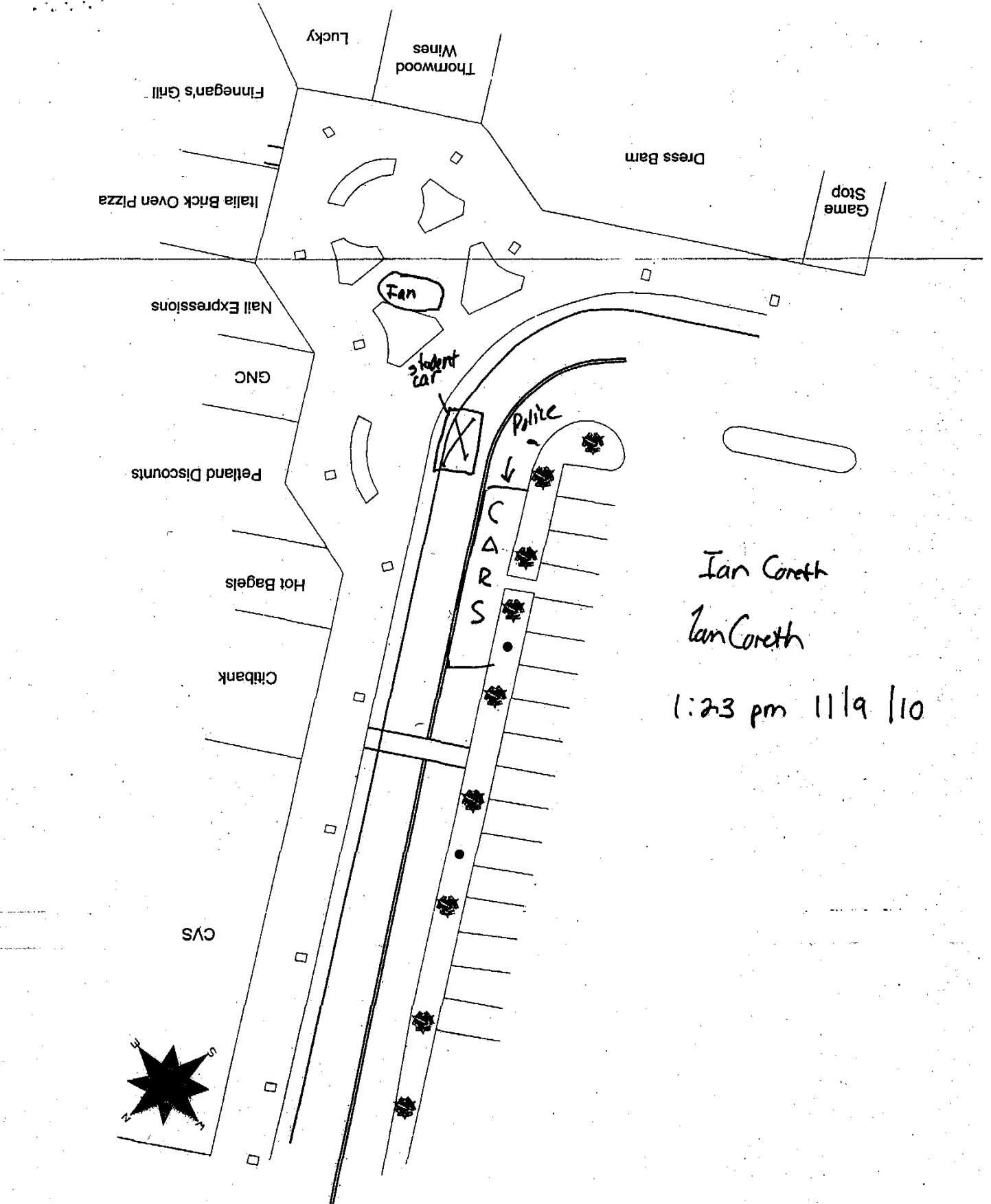
