We arrived at 12:30 am, after being IDed and stamped at the door. We waited approximately 10 minutes for our first round of drinks on the right corner of the bar. The bar was crowded and the (AK) spirits were high. Mid joke we looked to our right shoulder at the entrance of the bar. A fight between a bouncer and a tall, muscular white kid (AK) man had broken out. Bouncer's shirt (AK) shirt was ripped. Bouncer turned lights on

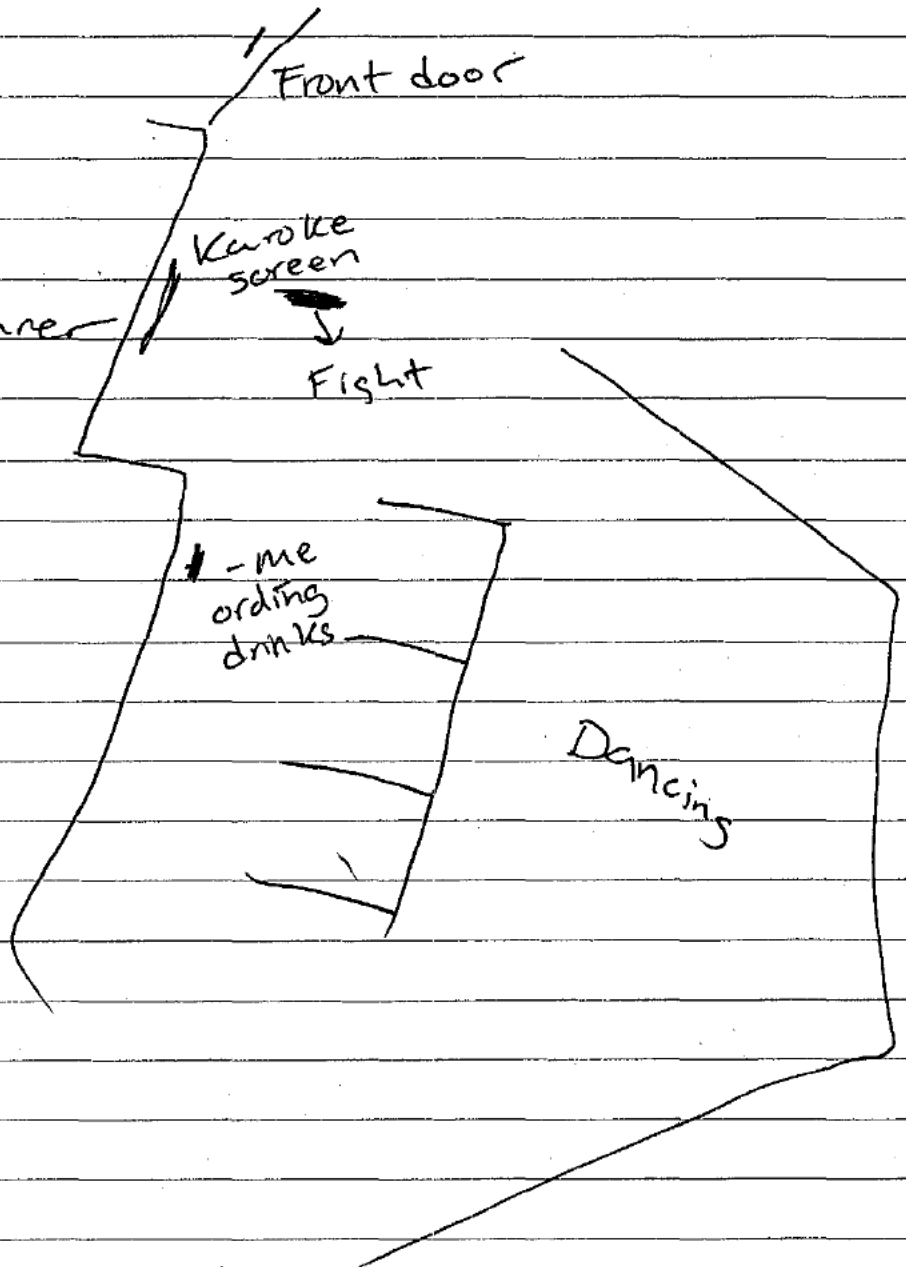
