I, DESMOND HINDS AGE 21, GIVE THIS TRUE AND VOLUNTARY STATEMENT TO DET GREENBERG OF THE MT PLEASANT POLICE DEPARTMENT.

I AM A SENIOR, I PLAY RECEIVER FOR THE PACE FOOTBALL TEAM. SATURDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2010 WE PLAYED A 1:00PM GAME AGAINST STONE HILL COLLEGE. ABOUT 8:30PM I WENT UP TO THE TOWNHOUSES, TOWNHOUSE 10, TO MEET UP WITH DJ HENRY AND HIS FRIEND FROM BOSTON, BRANDON BUT I DON'T KNOW HIS LAST NAME. I HAD MARTIN LAROCHE WITH ME. DJ'S ROOMMATE KEON WAS ALSO THERE. WE WERE WATCHING THE WISCONSIN GAME AND STARTED PLAYING VIDEO GAMES, HAD SOME VODKA. I HAD TWO CUPS OF VODKA. I SAW DJ HAVE A CUP OF VODKA, I'M NOT SURE HOW FULL. WE LEFT FOR FINNEGANS AROUND 10:30PM BECAUSE EVERYONE FROM THE TEAM WAS GOING. FINNEGAN'S WAS PRETTY CROWDED. THE FIVE OF US WERE MOSTLY BY THE DANCE FLOOR. I DID NOT SEE IF THE OTHER GUYS DRANK BUT I TURNED DOWN DRINKS. I NEVER SAW DJ LEAVE BUT WHEN THE LIGHT CAME ON DJ WAS ALREADY GONE. I WALKED OUT BY MYSELF, THE MAJORITY OF THE PEOPLE HAD LEFT AND WERE LEAVING. I GOT OUTSIDE AND I SAW DJ AND HIS FRIEND BRANDON BY HIS CAR WHICH WAS PARKED IN THE FIRELANE IN FRONT OF DRESS BARN FACING FINNEGANS. HIS CAR WAS STILL RUNNING. I WALKED OVER AND I HOPPED IN THE BACK, BRANDON GOT IN THE FRONT PASSENGER SIDE AND DJ GOT IN THE DRIVER'S SEAT. ABOUT 15 SECONDS LATER I HEARD A HARD TAP ON THE DRIVER'S SIDE WINDOW AND SAW A COP TAPPING DJ'S WINDOW WITH A FLASHLIGHT. DJ PULLED OFF WENT AROUND THE BEND AND GOING AT A DECENT SPEED. I LOOKED DOWN FOR A SECOND AND WHEN I LOOKED UP I SAW WHAT LOOKED LIKE A PERSON IN FRONT OF THE CAR THAT APPEARED THAT HE HAD HIS HANDS UP TOGETHER AND THEN I SAW TWO TO THREE HOLES IN THE FRONT WINDSHIELD. I DIDN'T SEE OUT THE FRONT BECAUSE THE FRONT WINDOW HAD CONDENSATION. I HAVE NO IDEA WHY DJ DIDN'T STOP. THE CAR STOPPED, AND DON'T KNOW HOW. I REMEMBER BEING TAKEN OUT OF THE CAR. MY ASSUMPTION IS THAT THE COP THAT ORIGINALLY TAPPED ON THE CAR WANTED US TO MOVE.

I AM AT THE MOUNT PLEASANT POLICE DEPARTMENT WHERE I AM GIVING THIS STATEMENT TO DET MARTIN B. GREENBERG WHO IS TYPING IT FOR ME, AND I HAVE READ IT AND IT IS THE TRUTH.

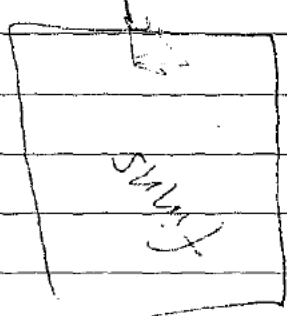
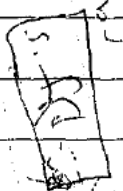
