

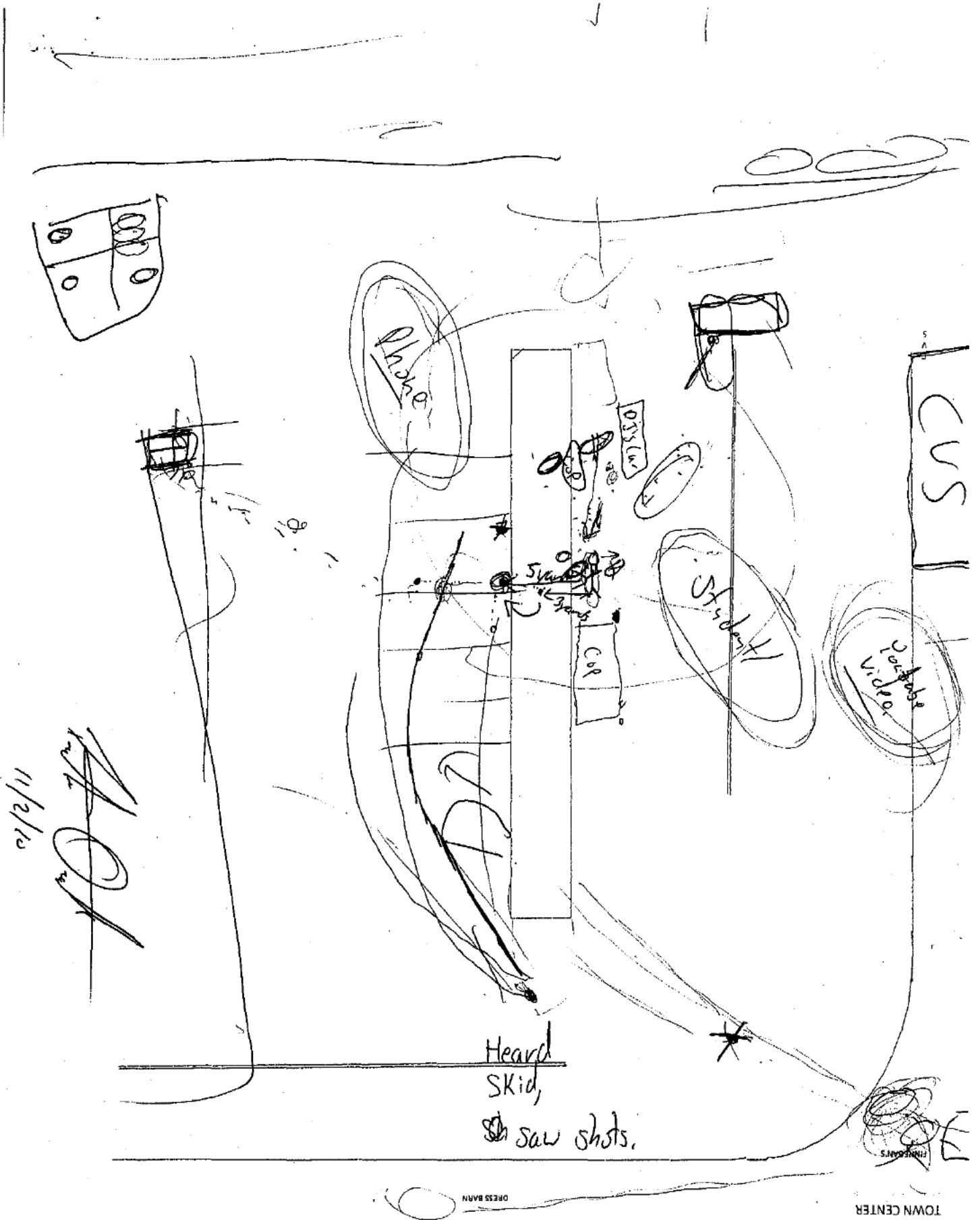

**CONFIDENTIAL**

On 10/16/10, I went to Finnegan's sometime around 11:00pm. I was with Ali Naveed. As I was walking in, I saw DJ and his onterache walking in from the opposite side of the road. He was with 5 or 6 other guys. I know he was with grey hoody guy, Yeves, Des, and somebody else. I walked in first and waited for them to come in. As they walked in, I said whats up to them. I then walked over to the dance floor and hung out there for about 3 minutes. I then walked back out to the car and put my jacket in the car. I walked back in and then hung around for 20 minutes. I then went to the bar and got a drink since I was the designated driver. I was hanging Carl Thomas. At the end of the night, there was a small girl fight by the bar area that I did not see. I don't know who it was. A few minutes later, a bouncer walks into the bar and said why the fuck is the music still on. Everybody get the fuck out. The bouncer starts making his way to the DJ, the music cuts, and he lights come on. Everybody is chanting, laughing, jokes because they don't want to leave. I noticed that the bouncer had a pulled polo shirt. I then walk out of the bar and walk toward my car that was parked in the second row across CVS. I noticed that none of my friends were there so I proceeded to head back to the bar. While walking I saw a light skuffle, people pushing people around. I noticed one of my friends there. I jogged over to see what was going on. I start walking back to my car and I get to the end of the median and I hear a burn out skid or a hard break. So I turn my head to the right and see a police officer roll over the driver side headlight area of a car. I see his left hand go in the air. I don't remember seeing anything in his hand. I remember the officer roll off the hood. I also hear 3 or 4 gunshots. I still see the vehicle moving and then I hear a metal to metal thud. I see the top of the car shake then drifts a little bit more to the right and then 3 more gun shots. The car was stopped when the shots were fired. I then run in the parking lot to see what was going on. I see a black male in a gray hoodie get taken down by a police officer and cuffed. I also see a black male in a plaid shirt passed by, by one or two officers. Then get taken down from behind by a police officer and cuffed. I see a police officer on my left lying on the ground. A lady in a white top helping him. She puts a white towel over his right thigh. I assumed he got shot so I immediately called 911. After the call, I walked back to a police car and saw a black male in a plaid shirt lying on the ground. He was hand cuffed and lying on his back with his head tilted to the left. I saw a lady turned his head and saw that it was DJ. I saw blood all over his nose, looked like red marks on the left side of his face. His right side was fine. Around 1 or 2 minutes later, a police officer rips DJ's plaid shirt open and DJ had a white tank top underneath. I noticed a red blood stain coming down from his arm pit down to his waist. I saw that his chest and stomach were white because of the tank top. I did not see any blood there. His chest was still moving up and down. The officer then walks away and DJ was unattended to for 3 or 4 minutes. During that point, I walk within 3 yards of DJ and I start to lift my shirt because I was going to take it off and aid him by stopping the bleeding. A near by officer stops me and tells me to get back. I request to help DJ, but the officer pointed at the lady attending to the officer on the ground to my left and stated that she would help instead. I took 3 steps back and watched. At that point the white shirted lady walks over to DJ and starts doing compressions on his chest with her hands. A officer brings the AED and comes over a minute later and as the officer and the lady hook DJ to the AED, then nearby lady attending to the officer in a white shirt attending to the officer that was hit and gave a sign to the woman attended to DJ that meant to me that
