POLICE OFFICER MPPD OET MATT BROWN NYSP INV CHRIS MULKINS OF THE MOUNT PLEASANT POLICE DEPARTMENT.

October 16, 2010 I was in my townhouse waiting to leave for the bar. Left for Finny's between 11 and 11:30 arrived. Saw the girls fighting inside. Later on around 1 or 1:30 the bouncer who was involved with fighting came in with his shirt ripped and told the DJ (Disc Sockey) to announce the bar was closed. At that point I walked out with Krystle Riden to stand and wait for a ride near the entrance of Dress Barn DJ's car was parked in the fire lane close to that area. Following this I saw DJ drive past where I was standing. About 50 ft. ~~from the car~~ I saw the officer ^{M/W} jump in front of DJ's car with his weapon drawn. It looked like he jumped on the hood to brace the impact. At this point I was directly behind the car and heard the two shots fired while seeing the gun be put close to the glass. After this the car kept moving and came to a stop when crashing into the other officer's car on the other side of the roadway. After seeing this I took Krystle and walked towards Shoprite to get away from the situation. Around 2 o'clock after seeing alot more police cars arrive I was picked up by Victoria Parcheck and came back to the townhouses. Around 3 we went to the ~~hospital~~ hospital and were told to go back to the school. M.W.

 hand close to the glass and I heard two pops. When the car came
